<p>BOSH Playscheme 2017 Evaluation</p>	<p>Evaluation of scheme presented.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All areas of Ramsey Parish represented • Gender split was approximately 50-50 • Came in on budget • Some sessions more popular than others but all well attended. <h2 style="text-align: center;">Parent Feedback</h2> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 100% of parents rated the scheme (out of 5) at 4 or above • 100% of parents said they would attend BOSH again • 100% of parents said they would recommend to a friend • 88% of parents knew BOSH had been funded by Ramsey Million Partnership • 28% heard about BOSH through Facebook • 17% heard about BOSH through Ramsey Neighbourhood Newsletter • 17% heard about BOSH through school • 17% heard about BOSH via word of mouth • 11% saw advertising about BOSH in a local newspaper • 10% saw advertising elsewhere, ie flyer, poster
