Plan Review	<p>Transport and Access</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Survey undertaken in 2017. The issues raised were consistent. i.e. difficulties getting to hospital appointments, work (especially shift work), Job Centre. Worked with Town, District and County Councillors and other community members/groups on resisting cut to number 30 service. Due to joined up working, including a petition of over 1,000 residents, a short reprieve until August has been given. Access – Many activities have been brought to Ramsey to provide access to activities that would otherwise require residents to travel out of the town. Examples of this include activities for families with young children, young people and the elderly via direct funding or grants.

	<p>The next steps</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pressure needs to be kept upon CCC to make adequate and suitable provision for Ramsey. Continue to work in partnership with RTC and local people and community groups, businesses. • Partners felt it was important to explore alternatives should the bus be lost. • Commission a consultant to look at (a) Ramsey Parish's transport requirements (b) alternative transport solutions.
